Our June meeting was held on June 26, 2019 and here are the some of the items that were discussed. Remember, this is just a brief summary of the meeting.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from our May 22, 2019 meeting were handed out and voted on and passed.

Introductions of all those in attendance, also the Officers of President and Treasurer and the substitute Secretary, Volunteers Trail Coordinator and Web Admin.

The Treasury report was given by Lynda F., Treasurer. Motion made to accept the report and passed.

The Woodsman Field days will be August 16, 17 and 18. Again this year, the club will have a table set up for the event. We will be selling Lewis County ATV Trail system maps, t-shirts, hats and coozies and have club applications available. Also, several drawigs for gifts to be finalized at the July 24 meeting. We are looking for volunteers to staff the table. There will be 2 people per shift. Ideally, 2 persons in the morning and 2 in the afternoon each day. If you can be there all day, even better! The status of our goals to expand NOCATV Club trails and also extend the Lewis County ATV Trail System down to the village of Boonville continues.

The current trail expansion NOCATV Club has been working is a Lewis County ATV Trail System connector from the Village of Boonville to some point on the existing southern end of the Lewis County ATV System trails. As of this meeting, we continue to get signatures from landowners who are ok with having the trail cross their land.

Also, on the Great Lot section of the Lewis County ATV Trail, a new bridge for crossing the stream is being worked on.

The NOCATV Club trail status was presented by John F, Trail Coordinator

Our goal of trail expansion of the NOCATV Club trails is being reviewed by the landowner. Our Trail Coordinator has heard from the landowner and has been given a time frame of hopefully by the end of the year for a decision. This connector trail would connect 2 parcels we currently have riding permissions for. As in getting any ATV trails, it takes a long time and dedicated effort to get the required permissions from the landowner, village, town, county and state organizations. Thank you, John F. For your committed efforts on this. If anyone can help John in these efforts, contact us at the addresses below.

A new effort by Northern Oneida County ATV Club is in the early stages of investigation into the feasability of a trail from Boonville to Forestport. President Guy C. is working this. It has been difficult to get a point of contact and get a reply back to our requests but we will continue pursue this.

The Lewis County ATV Roundtable was held on June 10 at the Lewis County Search and Rescue in Lowville. Round table meetings are sponsored by Jackie Mahoney of the Lewis County Recreation Dept. Discussed were a new trail in northern lewis county and the complaints from towns regarding the damage to town roads from SNIRT sponsored by SnoPals snowmobile club. Remember, area ATV clubs receive nothing from SNIRT but bad press as to the damage caused by ATVs.

The next roundtable is scheduled for July 8, 5:00 pm at the Lewis County Chamber of Commerce location in Lowville. Open to all ATV enthusiasts.

The Lewis County ATV Trail System permit site is Lewis County ATV System Permit and was

shutdown for continuing technical issues.

Note that due to technical difficulties, no date has been given as to when the website will be back online. You can still purchase the permits in person thru the Lewis County Chamber or at the other sellers listed on the Lewis County ATV web page here.

If you have your current NOCATV Club membership card, bring it with you to receive your \$20 discount when purchasing your LV ATV Trail Permit from these sellers.

If you don't have a Lewis County ATV Trail System permit, here is your chance to ride the trail system without one. All day on August 1, 2 and 3 is a free weekend where a permit is not required to ride the off road sections. Come and explore what the trail system has to offer.

Northern Oneida County ATV Club is selling the official Lewis County ATV Trail System maps at the Boonville Town and Village Offices, the Boonville Chamber of Commerce, Fox Brothers Automotive and The Lodge at Headwaters. Call the offices to be sure someone is in the office when you visit. They are also available at our meetings.
