The status of our goals to expand NOCATV Club trails and also extend the Lewis County ATV Trail System down to the village of Boonville continues.

The Lewis County trail status was presented by Guy C.

The current trail expansion NOCATV Club has been working is a Lewis County ATV Trail System connector from the Village of Boonville to some point on the existing southern end of the Lewis County ATV System trails. As of this meeting, each landowner contacted, except one, had shown interest on having the trail cross their land. The one landowner is undecided at this time. We will continue working on this.

The NOCATV Club trail status was presented by John F, Trail Coordinator

Our goal of trail expansion of the NOCATV Club trails moved a step forward this month. Our Trail Coordinator met with the landowner to visually see the specific small area the club is considering crossing on his land with a short connector trail. John and the landowner rode the potential path the new trail will take and the landowner took notes and pictures of the area for his records. There were some concerns that still need to be addressed before the final go ahead. We will continue to work with the landowner to resolve the concerns. This connector trail would connect 2 parcels we currently have riding permissions for.

Without this connector trail, the other trail option requires a bridge over a stream and getting permits to build the bridge. At this time, its too much paperwork for one or two volunteers to handle. One of the two parcels currently has trails and the other substantial parcel has no trails built on it but we have permission to build new trails by the current landowner once we gain access..

A new effort by Northern Oneida County ATV Club is in the early stages of investigation into the feasability of a trail from Boonville to Forestport. President Guy C. is working this and waiting for feedback from multiple people to get the ball rolling.

The Lewis County ATV Roundtable was cancelled on May 13 at the Lewis County Search and Rescue in Lowville. Round table meetings are sponsored by Jackie Mahoney of the Lewis County Recreation Dept. The next roundtable is scheduled for June 10, 5:00 pm at the Lewis County Fire and Rescue in Lowville. Open to all ATV enthusiasts.

The Lewis County ATV Trail System permit site is <u>Lewis County ATV System Permit</u> A new option this year is if you have a current NOCATV Club membership card and want a LC Permit, you can now upload your membership card with your ATV registration while applying for the permit. This will get you the \$20 discount on the first permit.

Note that due to technical difficulties, the web site was shutdown but may be back online as this is written. You can still purchase the permits in person thru the Lewis County Chamber or at the other sellers listed on the Lewis County ATV web page.

Northern Oneida County ATV Club is selling the official Lewis County ATV Trail System maps at the Boonville Town and Village Offices and the Boonville Chamber of Commerce. Call the offices to be sure someone is in the office when you visit. They are also available at The Lodge at Headwaters in Boonville or at our meetings.
