The status of our goal to extend the Lewis County ATV Trail System down to the village of Boonville continues.

The current trail expansion NOCATV Club has been working is a Lewis County ATV Trail System connector from the Village of Boonville to some point on the existing southern end of the Lewis County ATV System trails. As of this meeting, we are waiting for a representative from OCDPW to get back to us concerning access to roads needed to connect to West Leyden. The NOCATV Club trail status was provided by John F, Trail Coordinator

The trail expansion of the NOCATV Club trails for a connector trail is being reviewed by the landowner. The landowner had given a time frame of hopefully by the end of the year for a decision.

This land will allow us to connect to parcels of land we already have permission to ride.

A number of years ago, the club trails extended into the Town of Forestport. A lawsuit was filed by a landowner against the town charging the town did not follow the procedures in opening the roads to ATVs. An environment study (SEQER) is required prior to opening a road and it was not done by the town.

This study has been in process for a few years but we have received word that it may be completed in time for a public hearing in September. Stay tuned and when a date is selected, we will let you know.

Attendance at the public meeting for support will be needed by anyone who is an ATV fan as numbers at these meetings shows town officials that their decisions affect more atv owners than those against it. We need to outnumber those against atvs at these public meetings.

A another effort by Northern Oneida County ATV Club in the early stages of investigation into the feasibility of a trail from Boonville to Forestport. President Guy C. is working this. It has been difficult to get a point of contact for legal access and get a reply back to our requests. We are now in contact with Senator Griffo's office with help on this matter.

As in getting any ATV trails, it takes a long time and dedicated effort by clubs to get the required permissions from the landowner(s), village, town, county or state organizations. Thank you, John F. for your committed efforts on these. If anyone can help John in these efforts, contact us at the addresses below.

The next Lewis County ATV Roundtable will be held on August 12, 5:00 pm at the new Lewis County Chamber of Commerce offices in the old Climax Bldg. Open to all ATV enthusiasts.

If you have your current NOCATV Club membership card, bring it with you to receive your \$20 discount when purchasing your LC ATV Trail Permit from these sellers.

If you don't have a Lewis County ATV Trail System permit, here is your chance to ride the trail system without one. All day on August 1, 2 and 3 is a free weekend where a permit is not required to ride the off road sections as shown on the Official Lewis County ATV Trail map. Come and explore what the trail system has to offer.

Northern Oneida County ATV Club is selling the official Lewis County ATV Trail System maps at the Boonville Town and Village Offices, the Boonville Chamber of Commerce, Fox Brothers Automotive and The Lodge at Headwaters. Call the offices to be sure someone is in the office when you visit. They are also available at our meetings.

A temporary new trail opened in the Town of Diana for the Bald Mountain Road between Long Pond Road and Bryant's Bridge Road. A Lewis County ATV Trail Permit is required. It is on the LC ATV Trail map. If you could document any time you check on it, travel it or inspect it, I would greatly appreciate the help patrolling it. This trail will close on August 31 per DEC! Another area to ride is a new St Lawrence County Trail that is getting closer to opening. The newest section of Multi-Use ATV Trail to open is from South Colton to Russell. The trail is 37 miles one way with 26 miles on private and state easement wooded trails, 7 miles on back town roads and 4 miles on county roads. It will start at Racquette Valley Fish and Game to Tooley Pond to Whippoorwill Corners Trail Head Parking by GT's Restaurant.

And finally, AMA support for new Lumberjack Trails Riding Adventure Area hearing and comment period scheduled on major access proposal. Significant opposition is expected from Siera Club and the Adirondack Council. OHV support is essential.

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation has announced a comment period and public hearing on the proposed update of the Treaty Line Unit Management plan for 19,186 acres in central New York. It is significant to AMA members and the entire northeastern U.S. OHV community, because a plan has been presented for a public OHV riding area, much of
