We received the bill for club insurance for June 1, 2022 thru June 1, 2023 for \$2500

Last year it was \$875. Both years the agent fees are about the same. As you can see it has almost tripled.

The increase is because the insurance company received a claim. It was not against this club. You should know almost all ATV clubs are on a group policy in NYS. Each club almost pays the same amount for the same policy thru the only company who underwrites ATV clubs in NYS.

As a small club we are within a few hundred dollars of the large clubs of what we pay. With that huge increase, it has put the club in financial jeopardy for next year. As of our current balance our income between now and next year will not be enough for the insurance next.

Therefore, the June meeting will cover the club options going forward including even shutting down the club and trails. Please come to the June meeting as we plan for next season. If you cannot attend, your comments or ideas are welcome by email.
